ZELDA SYMPHONY RETURNS TO TORONTO!

Back by Popular Demand, "The Legend of Zelda: Symphony of the Goddesses" Returns to the Sony Centre for the Performing Arts on Sept. 7 with Breathtaking New Material

(San Francisco, CA) August 26, 2013 – As part of the global "The Legend of Zelda: Symphony of the Goddesses" tour for 2013, the acclaimed concert will revisit the Sony Centre for the Performing Arts on September 7 and once again thrill music lovers and Zelda enthusiasts with Second Quest, including fresh and exciting new material exploring additional chapters from the Zelda franchise. Early ticket reservations are advised, as these exciting fan experiences are exclusive to Symphony of the Goddesses in Toronto and space is limited.
